

Workshop Regulatory data requirements and certifications

GS1 in Europe Data Excellence Day 2023

7 September 2023, Cologne (Germany)

The workshop regulatory data requirements and certifications were split up in three parts: continuation of the regulatory overview that is affecting the community, how to derive trusted data from the upstream certifications by using the GS1 Registries and a presentation on how GlobalG.A.P. is sharing benchmark data to improve processes at the source. The main takeaways for this workshop are:

- There are a lot of regulations and regulatory requirements coming our way in short time intervals, most of them from the European Union. It is an advantage to work collectively on this challenge and include new regulatory data requirements into the Global Data Model.
- Most certificates are linked to either products or companies/locations, so that they can be associated
 with GS1 identifiers like GTIN/GLN in the electronic data exchange.
 Industry is expecting GS1 to help defining a data structure for sharing certification data with business
 partners across the supply chain.
- Trust is key! The better the quality of data and the higher the trust, the less relevant the certificate itself will be over time.
- The presentation contains also the mentimeter results as conducted during the workshop.
